The International Schools Choral Music Society (ISCMS) was set up in 2007 to address the dire need to bring Western Choral music to International students in this region. The 2010 Choral Festival's work will be the Mozart Requiem. A choir of 200 will perform the piece, with orchestral performers from participating schools, joined by the newly established Beijing Youth Orchestra (BYO). The BYO comprises of musicians from two Conservatoires in China and the best players from six Beijing International schools. This will be a unique event that is not to be missed.

Tickets are now available! They are priced at 100, 150, 200, and 250 RMB. At the bottom of this information sheet is a reservation slip, which may be detached and submitted to our parent representative. We will email to confirm your ticket reservation. In the email, please include your name, email address and phone number, as well as the number of tickets you wish at 100, 150, 200, or 250 RMB. We are offering 4 tickets for the price of 3 until February 5th.

Once we have received your email, we will reply to confirm your reservation and assign the best possible seats to you, in order of priority corresponding to the date of reception of your message. These specific tickets will be held for you at the foyer desk in Dulwich College Beijing, and will be available for purchase from February 1st. If you wish to change the seats we have reserved for you at the time of purchasing, please feel free to do so. We are tentatively scheduling the ticket desk to be open between 2:30pm and 4:00pm every school day. Additionally, a student-run ticket desk will be available at all school lunch and break times. The ticket sales desk will be more fully during the festival which begins on February 24th. For patrons in Beijing, please pick up all reserved tickets by February 23.

Tickets must be processed with cash only; we are sorry to say that we are not able to process purchases with credit card or bank transfers at the school. If you wish to purchase tickets with a credit card, you may do so at www.beijingshomedelivery.com. (product code TI0037) The advantage of using this website is that the tickets can be delivered to you locally in Beijing from this organization. However, the special offer of 4 tickets for the price of 3 will not be available on this site, and there will also be an external 25RMB delivery charge from them.
